Local historian Linda Plunk shared some stories of Martin's past when she visited Kiwanis on October 4 and led an interactive question and answer session filled with memories and laughter. Among several topics she focused on were a former location of the Macedonia Primitive Baptist Church (the first church constituted in Weakley County in 1824) on a lot donated by George W. Martin on S. McCombs Street, the Varsity Theatre, filling stations, stores in downtown Martin, and more. She had with her a Friends of the Library 18-month calendar with many photographs of historic Martin and areas on the UT Martin campus.


