Morgan is a family nurse practitioner who has worked in health care for many years, and Precious is a certified massage therapist who works on relieving pain through various types of massage. Cornerstone has offered services for more than one year. These services include Functional Medicine, where they help patients identify the root cause of illnesses, correct underlying diseases, and improve health; IV Therapy, where there is hydration and replenishment of nutrients, vitamins, antioxidants, and mineral blends through IV infusions; and therapeutic massage, where they offer massage therapy to address pain and stress in the body to maximize movement and stimulate relaxation.
