Last Meeting: Empowering Communities—Caroline Ideus co-manager of the City of Martin Farmers Market, described the mission of the Northwest Tennessee Local Food Network when she visited Kiwanis. She explained that The Northwest Tennessee Local Food Network is a nonprofit organization dedicated to cultivating a strong, more resilient local food system. Through education, advocacy, and collaboration, the group facilitates connections with farmers, businesses, schools, and communities to ensure fresh, locally-grown food is accessible to all. Three projects of the Local Food Network are the Grow Food Challenge, a program inviting individuals, families, schools, and community groups across Northwest Tennessee to grow food and compost; the Northwest Tennessee Farm to School initiative, which focuses on growing healthy kids and strong communities by connecting students with local farms; and the third focus of promoting Northwest Tennessee Farmers Markets. She said that outreach in certain areas will have to be restructured because funds from several grants recently have been eliminated. She said that in the last few years the City of Martin Farmers Market has grown to the point where currently approximately 40 vendors participate.
